What are the RLDatix Safer Awards?

The RLDatix Safer Awards recognise and showcase the achievements and innovations of health and care teams across Asia-Pacific that strive to make their organisation, the people in them and the people they care for safer, particularly through workforce management, governance, risk and compliance.

How do I nominate for an award?

Nominations can be submitted by any Asia-Pacific health and care professional or team from public, private and not-for-profit organisations whose primary activities are health and care provision.

Nominations can be submitted online via the <u>Awards Nomination form</u>, or via email, by answering the questions relevant to the category you would like to nominate for and sending the completed document to: <u>kwills@rldatix.com</u> before the closing date.

Nominations close on 10th February 2023. Shortlisted organisations will be announced in due course. If your nomination is shortlisted, we may reach out to you directly for further details on your submission.

Once nominations are closed, shortlisted entries will be assessed by a judging panel of independent health and care professionals, with finalists and winners of each category announced at the **People Summit Gala and Awards Night** on **8th March 2023**.

This year's RLDatix Safer Awards include 3 categories.

Safer & Operationally Sustainable Organisation Award

Awarded to a health and care organisation that applies a holistic approach to ensuring operationally sustainable initiatives that support their organisation, workforce and people they care for. This approach should be underpinned by an intention to create a safe care setting for all.

Safer & Supported Workforce Award

Awarded to a health and care organisation that strives to support their workforce's wellbeing and create a safe and supportive environment. The organisation should provide a positive experience for their workforce through technology and encourage candour that supports staff retention.

Safer & Better Client or Patient Journey Award

Awarded to a health and care organisation, site or team that puts patient-centric care at the heart of everything they do. They should provide their workforce with the knowledge, tools, resources and support required to improve their client or patient's experience within their organisation.

Carefully consider the requirement for each category before writing your nomination, to make sure that your project or initiative is nominated for the most appropriate category.

To help you create an effective nomination, we've collated a few hints and tips to consider when completing your entry.

Before you start:

- Familiarise yourself with the award categories and the initiative you're planning on entering.
- Get leadership buy-in make sure your organisation is supportive of your submission.
- Gather statistics and data which can be used as evidence for your submission, and check the numbers support your narrative.
- Source testimonials from other colleagues before you start writing so they can be woven into the content.
- Confirm who needs to sign off the entry. Put time in their diary now to make sure they'll
 be able to do it before the deadline.

When writing your entry, try to include:

- Evidence that describes how the initiative meets the award criteria.
- **An explanation** of how the RLDatix company or our governance, risk, compliance and/or workforce solutions supported this project, if applicable.
- A narrative or story through every answer to help the judges understand the challenges faced, actions taken, and results or goals met.
- Evidence of the **qualities of your entry** that make the project or initiative exceptional, and that are clearly relevant to the award criteria this could be stories, illustrations, statistics and testimonials from users/other stakeholders.

Key things to remember:

- There is no limit on how many categories you can enter or nominate for. However, if you enter two categories, you must submit a different project or initiative in each category.
- The judges will **not have any background information** on your project and may not be familiar with specific terminology or abbreviations.
- The deadline for entries is **Monday 10th February 2023**.
- The winners will be announced at the Gala Dinner and Awards Night on 8th March –
 make sure you've reserved your place to join us as we celebrate the entries and
 winners!
